The precepts of the Lord give joy to the heart.

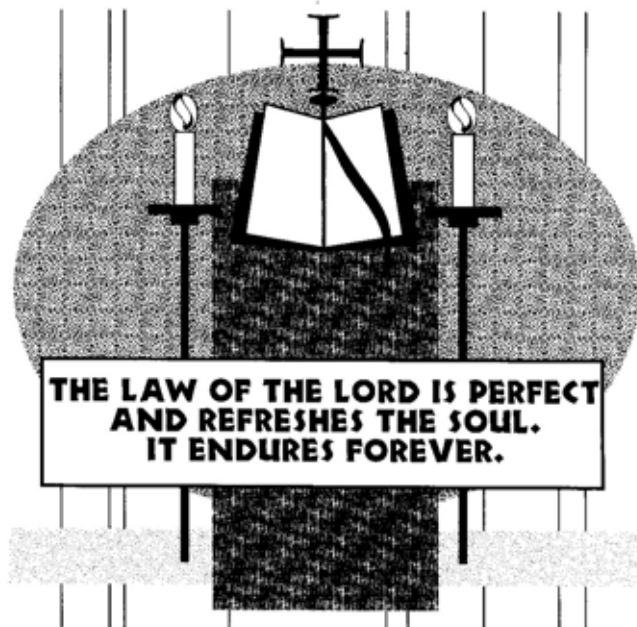
**SECOND READING:** James 5:1-6

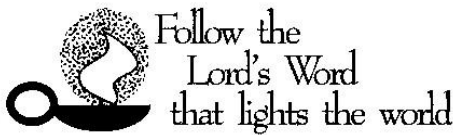
