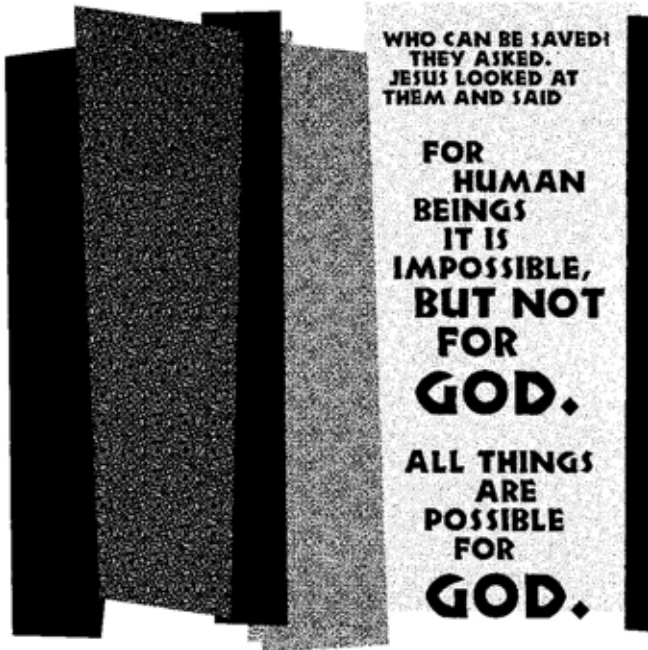

Introduction: The formation of the disciples was a major objective of Jesus as recorded in St Mark's Gospel, as we are reading it in these weeks. The attitude to riches and wealth are still issues of great



FIRST READING: Wisdom 7:7-11

We hear a personalised style of reflection from the Book of Wisdom which tells us what is true wisdom. In this passage the prayer of King Solomon shows the maturity of his thought and value systems.

Response: Psalm 89

Fill us with your love, O Lord, and we will sing for joy!

SECOND READING: Hebrews 4:12-13

We hear one of the shortest passages ever chosen but still one of the richest. This reflection on the power of the Word of God is the challenge to listen and absorb God's Word.

Gospel Acclamation: Sung Alleluia

GOSPEL READING: Mark 10:2-16

As Jesus forms his disciples, the exuberance of the rich young man provides a context for Jesus to elaborate on the deepest of Gospel values. Even the apostles were shocked at the consequences of his teaching.
