Introduction: The particular formation by Jesus of the disciples for their mission connects with our responsibility by our own Baptism to reflect on our capacity to participate in the mission of the Church.



FIRST READING: Isaiah 53:10-11

Isaiah's writings about the Suffering Servant of God are fulfilled in the mission of Jesus and his acceptance of his suffering and death.

Response: Psalm 32

Lord, let your mercy be on us, as we place our trust in you.

SECOND READING: Hebrews 4:14-16

This passage from Hebrews develops parallels between the roles of the high priests of the temple and the role of Jesus as our high priest who takes on the sin of the world.

Gospel Acclamation: Sung Alleluia

GOSPEL READING: Mark 10:35-45

As Jesus challenges his disciples, can they drink the cup that he must drink his disciples are at their own games. At the very daunting prospect for Jesus' destiny, the sons of Zebedee are seeking favours from Jesus on the side.

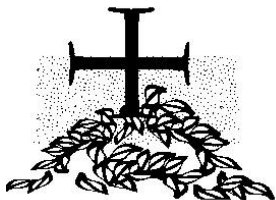

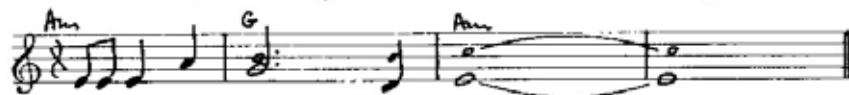
