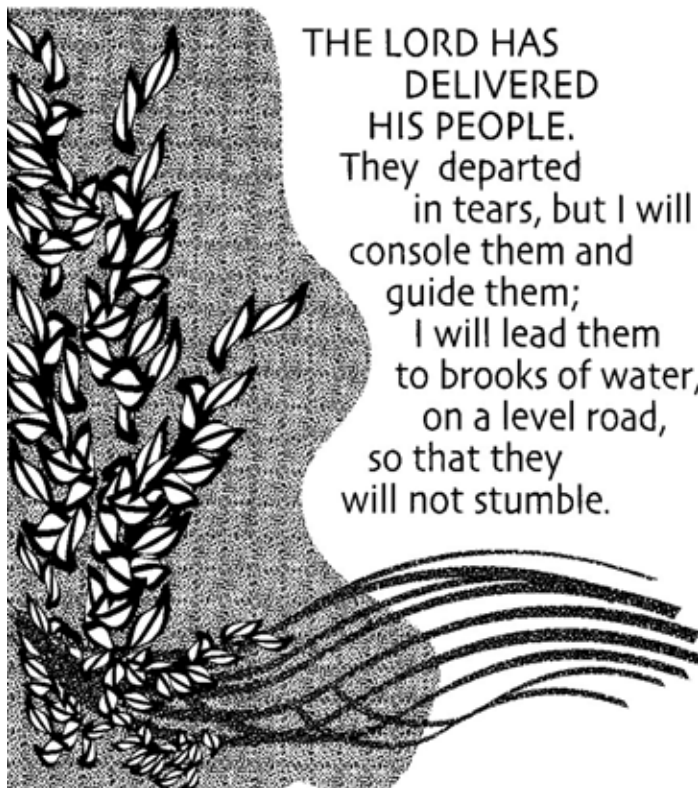

Introduction: We come to our final stage in St Mark's Gospel in which we have shared the journey of the disciples as Jesus forms them for their mission.

FIRST READING: Jeremiah 31:7-9

The prophet Jeremiah reassures the people at a time of conflict and suffering that the Lord God will save the faithful remnant of this people. One of the signs of this is gathering those in need, like those with problems of sight, which connects this to our Gospel passage.

Response: Psalm 125

The Lord has done great things for us; we are filled with joy.

SECOND READING: Hebrews 5:1-6

Another classic passage from the letter to the Hebrews about the differences between the high priests of the temple and Christ as priest of the order of Melchizedek.

Gospel Acclamation: Sung Alleluia

GOSPEL READING: Mark 10:46-52

We hear of the large crowd who followed Jesus when they passed by a blind beggar by the side of the road. Hearing it was Jesus of Nazareth, Bartimaeus acclaims Jesus as Son of David, thus evoking from Jesus his affirmation that it is his faith that has saved him.

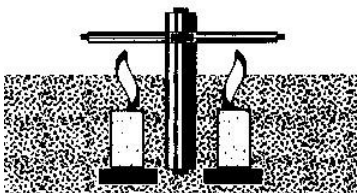
